## 20.07.25

## 21.07.25

### Delhi – Chandigarh - Rewalsar

160 km / 4 hrs.

Drive to New Delhi Railway Station and then by train to Chandigarh (5:50 - 8:38 am). Pick up there and continue with the guide to Rewalsar. The Rewalsar Lake is sacred and significant for Hindus, Sikhs and especially Buddhists.

Accommodation: The Mountain Paradise

## 22.07.25

### Rewalsar - Manali

130 km / 4,5 hrs.

The drive from Rewalsar to Manali leads through winding mountain roads, past dense forests, terraced fields and traditional villages, with marvellous views of the Kullu Valley and the surrounding peaks. Stop in Nagar if desired - or more time in Manali

Accommodation: Fog Hills Cottages

Meals: breakfast, dinner

Others: car, Guide

## 23.07.25

### Manali - Chandertal

110 km / 3,5 hrs.



The journey takes you through the modern Atal Tunnel and further along narrow, partly unpaved mountain roads that lead through the barren, rugged terrain of the Lahaul Valley along the Chenab River. Passing snow-capped peaks and glacial streams, you finally reach the high mountains, where the sparkling Chandertal Lake lies in the middle of the rocky desert. Lake Chandertal, also known as 'Mondsee', captivates with its crystal-clear, turquoise water and the tranquil, almost magical atmosphere at an altitude of 4,300 metres. A round trip takes approx. 1 hrs.

## 24.07.25

### Chandertal - Kaza

100 km / 3,5 hrs.

Continue over the Kunzum-la Pass (4,550 m) to Spiti. Along the Spiti River through the villages of Losar, Hansa, Rangrik etc. to the small capital Kaza. Stops where desired.

Accommodation: Deyzor

Meals: breakfast, dinner

Others: car, Guide



## 25.07.25

### Kaza - Langza

16 km / 45 min

The road winds its way up to 4,200 metres to the small village of Langza. Here there is time to explore the area, visit the large Buddha statue and look for fossils.

Accommodation: Lara's Homestay

Meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner

## 26.07.25

### Langza - Komik

4.200 m → 4.450 m / 4 hrs.

Through the village of Hikkam (highest post office), you will follow hiking trails to one of the highest villages in the world: Komik. There you can visit an old monastery of the Sakya order (Tangyud) and a new building.

Accommodation: Homestay

Meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner

## 27.07.25

### Komik - Demul

4.450 m → 4.750 m → 4.350 m / 5 hrs.

Over the Yang Labtse pass (4,750 m) with a great view of the nearby ice giant Chau Chau Kang Nilda, we descend to the village of Demul with its very special village organisation in terms of homestays. Everything is organised very communally here.

Accommodation: Homestay

Meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner

Others: Guide, car for luggage transport



## 28.07.25

### Demul - Lhalung

4.350 m → 3.550 m → 4.200 m / 6 hrs.

Descend to the Lingti River (3,550 m), cross it on a bridge and on the other side, the trail continues uphill to the village of Lhalung with its very old monastery rooms. The monastery is from the same period as the one in Taboo and is home to some unique murals and sculptures.

Meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner

Others: Guide, car for luggage transport

## 29.07.25

### Lhalung - Dhankar

4.200 m → 3.890 m / 5 hrs.

High up along the river, the trail leads to the main valley, where it continues uphill to Dhankar. Visit the picturesque monastery there.

### 30.07.25

#### **Dhankar - Kaza**

33 km / 1 hrs.

It takes about 3 hours to hike to Dhankar Lake at 4,000 metres and back. Then drive by car to Kaza.

Meals: breakfast, dinner  
Others: Guide, car



### 31.07.25

#### **Kaza - sightseeing-trip**

The excursion from Kaza begins with a visit to the impressive Kye Monastery, which is perched on a hill overlooking the Spiti Valley. From there, the tour continues to the high-altitude village of Kibber, followed by a stop at the spectacular Chicham Bridge, the highest gorge bridge in Asia. After a drive through the rugged, impressive mountain landscape, you reach the remote villages of Gete and Tashigang, both of which are perched on breathtaking cliffs and offer unrivalled views of the Spiti Valley.

### 01.08.25

#### **Kaza - Taboo**

50 km / 1,5 hrs.

Drive to Taboo (3,300 m). You will have plenty of time to visit the old monastery and the cave monastery high above Taboo.

Accommodation: Spiti Mud Huts  
Meals: breakfast, dinner  
Others: Guide, car



## 02.08.25

### **Taboo**

Further stay in Taboo with a hike to Tabo Latse, a 4,100 m high mountain ridge that takes 2-3 hours to climb. This spiritual place also offers great views over the valley.

Accommodation: Spiti Mud Huts  
Meals: breakfast, dinner  
Others: Guide, car

## 03.08.25

### **Taboo - Nako**

75 km / 2 hrs.

First we continue along the motorway. A detour leads to Gue to the unique monastery with a 550-year-old mummy of a Buddhist monk. Nako is a village at 3,600 metres with a beautiful lake and a Buddhist monastery.

Accommodation: Kinner Camps  
Meals: breakfast, dinner  
Others: Guide, car

## 04.08.25

### **Nako - Kalpa**

110 km / 3 hrs.

The spectacular road leads down to the region of Kinnaur with its higher rainfall. Possibility of a stop in Poo with a temple founded by Rinchen Zangpo. A serpentine road leads to the impressively situated Kalpa.



Accommodation: Kinner Villa  
 Meals: breakfast, dinner  
 Others: Guide, car



## **05.08.25**

### **Kalpa - Sarahan**

95 km / 3 hrs.

The Bhimakali temple with its impressive architecture is located in Sarahan.

Accommodation: Shrikand  
 Meals: breakfast, dinner  
 Others: Guide, car

## **06.08.25**

### **Sarahan - Shimla**

160 km / 5-6 hrs.

Drive to Shimla and time to explore the former hill station with its colonial heritage.

Accommodation: Honeymoon Inn  
 Meals: breakfast, dinner  
 Others: Guide, car

## **07.08.25**

### **Shimla - Delhi**

The journey from Shimla to Delhi begins with a spectacular ride on the famous Kalka-Shimla narrow-gauge railway, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. As the train winds through over 100 tunnels and over numerous bridges, breathtaking views of the green hills of the Himalayas open up. In Kalka, you switch to the broad-gauge line, which takes you further through the plains of northern India, past villages, fields and bustling towns, until you finally reach the bustling city of Delhi.
